- 2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been compiled from the related standalone Ind AS financial statements which has been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with relevant rules issued thereunder ('Ind AS') and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the Statement based on our audit of such standalone financial statements.
- 3. We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. Those Standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Statement is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and the disclosures in the Statement. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the Statement, whether due to fraud or error. - c. gives a true and fair view in conformity with the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit, Total comprehensive income and other financial information of the Group for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019.
- 5. We did not audit the financial statements of a subsidiary included in the consolidated financial results, whose financial statements reflect total assets of Rs.10,160 lakhs as at 31st March 2019, total revenues of Rs.836 lakhs, total net profit after tax of Rs.15 lakhs and total comprehensive income of Rs.144 lakhs for the year ended on that date, as considered in the consolidated financial results. These financial statements have been audited by other auditors whose report has been furnished to us by the Management and our opinion on the consolidated financial results, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of this subsidiary is based solely on the reports of the other auditors.

Our opinion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matters with respect to our reliance on the work done and the reports the other auditors.

6. The comparative financial information for the year ended 31st March, 2018 in respect of a subsidiary prepared in accordance with the Ind AS and included in this Statement have been audited by other auditors whose report has been furnished to us by the Management and in so far as it relates to the comparative amounts and disclosures included in respect of this subsidiary, is based solely on the reports of the other auditors.

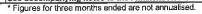

#### Notes:

- The above audited financial results for the year ended 31st March 2019, drawn in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as modified by circular no CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated 5th July 2016, have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their meeting held on 22nd May 2019 at Kolkata.
- 2 The figures for the 3 months ended 31st March 2019 and corresponding 3 months ended 31st March, 2018 are the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the year to date figures upto the third quarter of the respective financial years.
- 3 Consequent to the introduction of Goods and Service Tax (GST) with effect from 1st July 2017, Central Excise, Value Added Tax, Service Tax etc. have been replaced by GST. In accordance with Indian Accounting Standards, as applicable, and Schedule III to the Companies Act 2013, GST are excluded from Revenue from Operations for applicable periods. In view of the above, Revenue from Operations for year ended 31st March 2018 are not comparable with the other reported periods.
- The Operating segments are reported in a manner consistent with the internal reporting provided to the chief operating decision-maker (CODM). The CODM, who is responsible for allocating resources and assessing performance of the operating segments, has been identified as the Board of Directors. The operations of the Group pertains only to Material Handling Solutions (i.e. manufacturing and marketing of various Material Handling Equipments namely Mobile Cranes, Port Equipments, Self Loading Truck Cranes, Road Construction Equipments, etc. and dealing in spares and providing services to related equipments). Accordingly, the Group has only one reportable operating segment.
- 5 Effective 1st April 2018, the Group has adopted Ind AS 115-Revenue from contract with customer using the modified retrospective approach. The adoption of the standard did not have any material impact on the Financial Statements of the Group.
- 6 The Board of Directors have recommended a dividend of ₹ 1.75 ( 17.50% ) on each equity share for the year 18-19.
